**AccrualNet.cancer.gov** is an online community of practice designed to provide clinical trials professionals with a centralized resource for clinical trials recruitment resources, strategies and tools. It aims to improve accrual by making ‘checking the evidence’ a routine practice during the recruitment planning process.



Developed and supported by the National Cancer Institute (NCI), this community is both an information resource and a forum for asking questions, sharing suggestions, lessons learned, and useful resources with your clinical trial colleagues.



**Useful Content:** A growing repository of more than 700 resources aligned with each phase of the clinical trial accrual lifecycle. Find what you need when you need it.



**Education and Training Materials:** Professional education resources to help you train new team members and patient education materials to support your needs.



**Conversations:** A space for you to connect with clinical trial colleagues—ask questions, share experiences, solve challenges, and celebrate success.



**Communities:** Groups where members with a shared purpose convene around common challenges, discuss accrual issues, share documents, and collaborate with each other.
